#### World Population

At times it seems the world is a very crowded place. However, people live on farms, some live in villages, and others live in large metropolitan<sup>1</sup> areas of various sizes. Cities that were once small villages and towns have gradually grown and combined to become larger cities and in some cases, megacities.<sup>2</sup> A city's growth depends on many things, but the one thing that is becoming obvious is that the world population has grown steadily in the last 75 years.

Every 12-15 years since the year 1945 we have been adding a billion<sup>3</sup> people to the global population. Many think that a billion people are far too many for the earth to safely endure. Others have thought that there will be global food shortages or there will be a lack of work for so many people, but as growth continues, this has been proven to be false. In the future, if trends continue, the world will be more populated<sup>4</sup> and prospects for work and new jobs will continue to increase along with the global population.

Recently, the entire world has had a pandemic<sup>5</sup> based on a virus.<sup>6</sup> It has affected lives and stressed medical services. It has also forced many people around the world out of their work. It might be thought of as a population problem based on too many people, but traveling from one place to another has had more of an impact than the actual population. It is not the first time in human history for a pandemic to be a world problem.

In the year 1918, an influenza virus pandemic moved around the world. Even at that time, the world was a crowded place. The approximate world population was under 2 billion people, yet nearly 25 million<sup>7</sup> people died of influenza. In 1918, the specific influenza variety was particularly dangerous. Currently, we normally have a yearly increase in influenza cases in the winter. Having a vaccination<sup>8</sup> can help reduce the symptoms and severity.

We are always challenged to adapt and improve our way of life. The population is continually growing, and currently, the world population is about 8 billion people. The predictable future is for life as we know it to expand and for growth in population to continue around the world. Many opportunities to improve farming, urban<sup>9</sup> planning, and healthcare<sup>10</sup> systems will be part of the future. Ideally, a peaceful existence will be part of that future, too.




